Mother's Day Ideas

Card (I've packed colored paper for you to pick up with books on Tuesday):

I love this one! I've done it with my class in the past. It's easy and so sweet! Take a picture of your child holding their hands above their heads. Print it out (at home or Shoppers/Walmart). Cut around the picture so you only have the child. Fold a piece of colored paper in half like a card. Glue the picture of the child in the center (making sure there is room for a heart above it). Cut out a heart and have your child print the words "I Love You Mom!" – glue it on. If you have red paper use it but if not just have them color the heart red. Then you can decorate it however you like. If you have colored paper you can cut and glue on a sun, flowers, etc. If you don't have a lot of colored paper just draw and color.

On the inside have your child write a message to mom. It can be as simple as "Happy Mother's Day" or they can write a message saying why they love her. How about a poem?

it's your special day.


