Create a "How-To" book that teaches others how to make something/how to do something/how to play something.</p> <p><i>Please refer to "Grade 1 Word Wall List" attachment to help with spelling of sight words.</i></p>	<p>Write your double addition facts in order from 1+1 through 10+10. You may wish to write these with a pencil and paper or make it fun by writing them with a stick in the mud! Your choice 😊</p>
<p>Hide a simple treasure and create a map to lead someone to the treasure. Could that person find the treasure? How could you make it even better?</p>	<p>Measure how tall each person is in your home with household objects (cans, blocks, etc.)</p>
<p>Pick 10 sight words. Make your sight words using cereal, pasta or playdoh.</p> <p><i>Please refer to "Grade 1 Word Wall List" attachment.</i></p>	<p>Create <u>three</u> different fact families for the following 3 sets of numbers (2 addition facts and 2 subtraction facts for each set of numbers).</p> <p>10, 8, 2 10, 6, 4 10, 7, 3</p>
<p>Make a list of 10 things in your house that are blue. Be sure to stretch out your words so that you can hear all their sounds!</p>	<p>Write the addition fact or subtraction fact for at least <u>5</u> of the word problems.</p> <p><i>Please refer to "Word Problems Choice Board" attachment.</i></p>
