Choose 1-2 from Math and 1-2 from Literacy each day: (It's ok to do the same one on more than one day.)

Math

Count backwards from 10, start at 7, 9, 4, 8.

(7:7,6,5,4,3,2,1,0)

Literacy

(Example: bird, ball, bat, bug, bed, barn)

- Students are encourage to read/be read to for 30 minutes each day. This can be picture books, cartoons, recipes, magazines, audio books, etc. Because we are just beginning to read, we've learned 3 ways to read a book:
 - 1. Read by talking about the pictures.
 - 2. Read the words.
 - 3. Retell a book that someone has previously read to you.
