



# Questions to Ask When Reading



<b>Stories</b>	<b>Informational Text</b> (ex: <i>All About Snakes</i> )
<b>Before Reading</b>	
After looking at the cover and the pictures, what do you think is going to happen?	After looking at the cover and the pictures, what do you think the book will be about?
Does this book remind you of anything from your life?	What do you already know about this topic?
<b>During Reading</b>	
What do you think will happen next? Why do you think that?	What else do you think this book is going to teach about?
What can you tell me about the story so far?	What have you learned from this book so far?
What emotion do you think the character is feeling? Why do you think that? How would you feel if that happened to you?	What do you think this page was mostly about?
Why do you think the character did that? What would you do if you were in that situation?	What features do you see on this page? (Table of contents, captions, labels, headings, bold words)
Can you put what we just read into your own words?	Can you put what we just read into your own words?
<b>After Reading</b>	
Were your predictions correct?	Were your predictions correct?
Who was the story about? Can you tell what happened to them in the beginning, middle, and end?	What were the most important things from this book? What were the most interesting things from this book?
What questions would you ask the author, if you could?	What else do you want to know about this topic? How could you find out? (Google, Ask Siri, another book, etc.)
Is there anything the author/illustrator did that you really liked? How could you try to do that in your writing/drawing?	Is there anything in this book that you might want to try to copy when you make books?
