## Home Learning: Friday, November $12^{\text {th }}$

## Literacy:

- Read a book together or watch a story: https://storylineonline.net/library/ **After reading, ask your child what their favourite part of the book is and why.
- Watch this alphabet song, say letter names and sounds: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=36IBDpTRVNE
- Review the letter game if your child doesn't recognize letters up to J yet.
- No Writing today, we will work on rhyming. Complete the second rhyming sheet in this week's package. Say the picture names and have your child circle the pairs that rhyme. Now look around your house for an item that rhymes with:
red (bed, head)
Pam (ham, jam)
lock (clock, block)
- Click and complete the activities for the letter M. (Click on any letters/pictures that are twinkling to complete the full activities) https://www.starfall.com/h/abcs/
- Practice printing the letter Mm. Use whiteboard marker and trace over letters on clear plastic folder (Yellow sheet is inside). Follow the numbers on each letter for correct formation. Wipe off with pompom.
- We have reviewed the letters we learned so far in class.

Beginning on Monday, we will start with Nn and spend 2 days on each new letter (sound, songs, activities, crafts, practice printing, etc.)

## Numeracy:

- Watch this video about Milo the Monster making patterns: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fo5cjg15_5s
- Complete worksheet \#4 - Patterns - This is the last sheet in the math booklet. Go over each pattern and say it out loud. Then circle which object would finish that pattern. If you would like to turn some of these into a colour pattern, that would be great!
- Review 1 more: Using the numberline and a block, ask your child to show you 1 more. You call out a number between 0-9, have your child put the block on the number that is 1 more and tell you what that number is. If you can only go up to 5, that's fine.
