### Literacy:

- Read a book together or watch a story <https://storylineonline.net/>  
\*\*Before you open the book or press play, have your child predict what is going to happen in the book.
- Watch this Zoophonics song, say letter names and sounds:

- Watch this Alphabet song and sing along!

- Play the letter game that was sent home last week if your child is still have a hard time remembering letter names.
- No writing today, but there is a rhyming sheet in the baggie to complete. Draw a line to join the 2 pictures that rhyme. Now look around your house for an item that rhymes with:  
sock (if your child can't think of anything, suggest: clock or rock)  
mat (cat, hat)  
pan (can, fan)
- Click and complete the activities for the letters G, H (Click on any letters/pictures that are twinkling to complete the full activities)

- Practice printing the letters Gg Hh. Use whiteboard marker and trace over letters on clear plastic folder. Follow the numbers on each letter for correct formation. (Yellow sheet is inside) Wipe off with pompom.
