## <u>Literacy:</u>

- Review the letter game if your child doesn't recognize letters up to J yet.
- Writing Workshop Using a piece of writing workshop paper, draw a picture of something you've done over the past couple of days. Have an adult print your sentence at the very bottom, and then you can copy the sentence on the line to practice spaces and letter formation. I always model correct spaces and correct letter formation (uppercase/lowercase letters). Even though it's not an expectation at this time, students will follow what is modelled for them.
- Instead of letter practice today, watch my video from this morning and make a poppy using the sheet with 4 hearts and a circle. I gave you some extra copies in case someone else in your house would like to make one, too.
