

Home Learning: Wednesday, November 3rd

Literacy:

- Read a book together or watch a story <https://storylineonline.net/>
Get your child to tell you how the story ended and ask them if they would change the ending to something else.
- Watch this Zoophonics song, say letter names and sounds:

- Play the letter game that was sent home last week if your child is still have a hard time remembering letter names up to Jj.
- Writing - Use a piece of Writing Workshop paper and draw a picture of something you've done while you've been at home. Get an adult to help you write a sentence. They can write the sentence at the bottom of the page, and you can copy it on the line. Practice putting spaces between words.
- Click and complete the activities for the letters C, D (Click on any letters/pictures that are twinkling to complete the full activities)

- Practice printing the letters Cc, Dd. Use whiteboard marker and trace over letters on clear plastic folder. Follow the numbers on each letter for correct formation. (Yellow sheet is inside) Wipe off with pompom.

Numeracy:

- Pattern Song - Banana, Banana, Meatball

- Math Sheet - Pattern - this is the last sheet in math booklet (we'll finish the number sheets on another day). Go over each pattern, say the pattern out loud. Then, circle which object would finish that pattern. If you would like to turn some of these patterns into a colour pattern, too, that would be great!

- Practice counting objects: Set out 5 small objects that are the same (coins, paper clips, spoons, etc.) and practice counting backwards. If counting from 5 is mastered, work on counting backwards from 10.

Extra: Students can work on Squiggle Park (Literacy). World 1 games practice letter recognition. Students can work on DreamBox (Numeracy).
