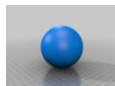
Practice writing numbers:

- Students are encourage to read/be read to for 30 minutes each day. This can be picture books, cartoons, recipes, magazines, audio books, etc. Because we are just beginning to read, we've learned 3 ways to read a book:
 1. Read by talking about the pictures.
 2. Read the words.
 3. Retell a book that someone has previously read to you.
