**Target Number Card Game Materials: Deck of cards-face cards removed**

Shuffle and deal out four cards for each player. Then flip the top card from the deck over in the center of the table. This is the **Target Card**.

Then, with the cards in your hands, you have to add or subtract to get to the target number. The goal is to do it with all four cards. If you get to the target number, you get a point. Then dump your cards and the target number and deal out again. Repeat it until someone gets to three points first

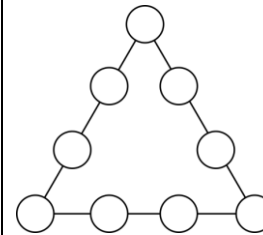

**Magic Square**













15 is the magic number. Every row, column and diagonal adds up to it. Use the numbers from 1 to 9 only once on a 3 by 3 grid. Can you do it?
