<p>Make a book. Staple or fold 3-4 pages together. Write and illustrate your own story and read it to a family member.</p>	<p>Find 3 different containers in your house that are about the same size (jar, cup, food container, etc.). Estimate which do you think will hold more? Which will hold less? Use a large spoon to find out by counting how many scoops it will take to fill each. Did any of your answers surprise you? Record your answers.</p>
<p>Write out sight words on paper plate targets and stick them up on a wall. When you call out a word, your child must find the "target", read it, and throw a ball to hit it. <i>Please refer to "Grade 1 Word Wall List" attachment.</i></p>	<p>Try more or fewer. Look around your house. Does your family have more spoons than forks? Fewer beds or fewer pillows? More windows or more doors? Record your answers. Think of something else in your house that you can compare.</p>
