

Guests arrive at NSEE

On a cold February morning this month, a few hundred guests arrived at the office of North and South Esk Elementary Mrs. Sillikers class, looking for a warm cozy place to stay for a few months. No, not political refugees but red wigglers! The Northumberland Solid Waste Commission (NSWC) has provided several area schools with a Vermicomposter kit. Essentially, a Vermicomposter uses red wigglers, a species of earthworm, to breakdown kitchen scraps and turn them into compost.

In your garden this process is done naturally by worms and the millions of bacteria, protozia and nematodes that exist in the soil. In full operation the composter can house as many as 10,000 worms and process 1.5-2kg of food waste and shredded paper a week.

The composted scraps will be used to start some annuals for the flowerbeds around the flags at the front of the school, in time for graduation ceremonies this June. It's a win-win situation for the school, the worms, the flowerbeds and the students at NSEE who will learn a valuable lesson in reducing, reusing and recycling..
